St. Olaf's Day



Maybe next year the lodge will have a program honoring St Olaf.

St. Olaf's Day, is celebrated on July 29th to commemorate King Olaf II of Norway, who later became the country's patron saint. In 1030 Olaf was killed in one of the most famous battles in the history of Norway. After the battle the king's body was carried away and buried secretly in the sandy banks of the Nidelva River south of the city of Trondheim.

The year after the battle, his grave and coffin were opened and the body was incorrupt and the hair and nails had grown since he was buried. The coffin was then moved to St. Clement's Church in Trondheim. It is here that the beatification actions took place.

A monument was erected on top of the stone against which St Olaf died. The stone is supposedly still inside the altar of the church. During the pontificate of Pope Alexander III, the Roman Catholic Church declared Olaf a saint in 1164.
